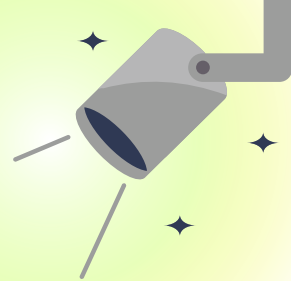


"The Bee Tree" by Patricia Polacco

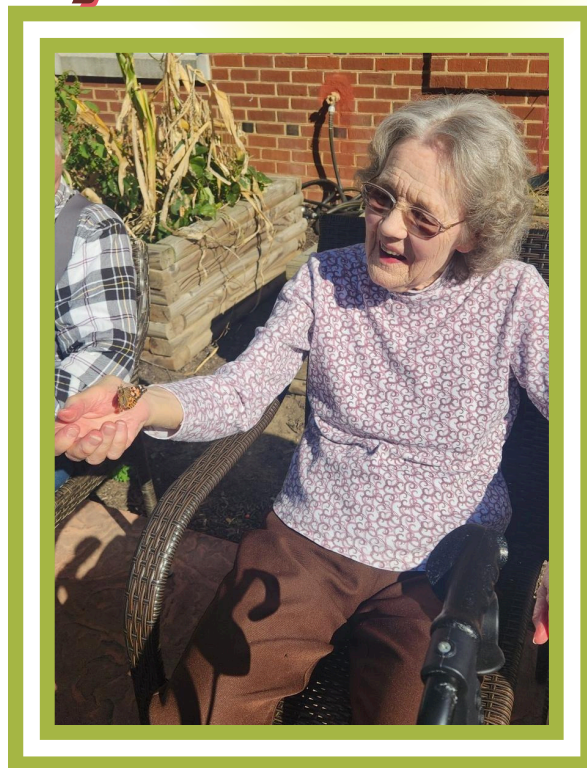
